Election of Members to the YLS Executive Committee

The West Virginia State Bar Board of Governors provides for the selection of a Young Lawyers Section Executive Committee to be elected by the Young Lawyers membership for a three-year term. One Executive Committee member is elected from each State Bar District, with the exception of District 8 where two Executive Committee members are elected. This year, elections will be held in State Bar Districts 6 through 10.

Nominations for Executive Committee membership are made by written petition signed by, not less than, 10 Young Lawyers of the <u>same</u> district in which they and the nominee have their principal offices for the practice of law. Where there are fewer than ninety (90) young lawyers in a District, the signature of ten percent (10%) shall be sufficient. The counties comprising the Districts are:

- 6 McDowell & Mingo (2 required to nominate)
- 7 Boone, Logan & Lincoln (2 required to nominate)
- 8 Kanawha (10 required to nominate)
- 9 Raleigh & Wyoming (4 required to nominate)
- Mercer, Summers & Monroe (2 required to nominate)

The Young Lawyers Section consists of all State Bar members who have been in the practice of law for less than 10 years and/or are 35 years of age or younger.

A nominating petition is located on the back of this page. A copy of the nominating petition can also be found on The State Bar website under the For Attorneys tab, under Forms. When signed by the requisite number of members, the petition must be <u>received</u>, by mail, email or fax no later than midnight <u>February 10, 2017</u> by the Executive Director, The West Virginia State Bar, 2000 Deitrick Boulevard, Charleston, WV 25311-1231; <u>caseya@wvbar.org</u>; or fax 304.553.7228. If multiple copies of the petition are used, they must be sent together. Note that the By-Laws states, in pertinent part: <u>No member shall sign more than one nominating petition in any year.</u>

All new Young Lawyer Section members will be required to attend training on March 27, 2017, beginning at 10 am at the State Bar Center in Charleston. If you cannot participate in person you can arrange to participate via video conference. Attendance at the Annual Meeting on April 2 at 11 am in Charleston is also required.
