Nomination Procedure

This award is meant to honor a seasoned lawyer who has provided mentorship and guidance to young lawyers. Nominations may be made by any young lawyer who would like to nominate his or her mentor, or by anyone who knows a lawyer who helps mentor young lawyers.

Nominations should include:

1. The name and address of the nominee.
2. A brief biographical account of the nominee's legal career.
3. A brief statement — including examples — explaining why this person is a great mentor.
4. The identity of the person making the nomination.

Nominations may include any other relevant information.
