RE: Election of Governors to the Board of Governors

The By-Laws of the West Virginia State Bar provide for the election of a member to the Board of Governors for a four-year term beginning in April 2022, from State Bar Districts 13, 14, 15 and 16.

Nominations for the Board must be by written petition signed by, not less than, the number of members identified below who have their principal place of business in the same District as the nominee. No member shall sign more than one nominating petition in any year. The nominee must sign at least one of the petitions.

The counties comprising the electing districts and the number of required signatures are:

13 — Doddridge, Harrison, and Lewis (10 required to nominate)

14 — Marion and Monongalia (10 required to nominate)

15 — Barbour, Preston, Taylor, and Tucker (6 required to nominate)

16 — Berkeley, Grant, Hampshire, Hardy, Jefferson, Mineral, and Morgan (10 required to nominate)

A nominating petition is located on the back of this page. A copy of the nominating petition can also be found on the State Bar's website at [www.wvbar.org/2022Petition](http://www.wvbar.org/2022Petition). Once signed by the requisite number of members, the petition must be **RECEIVED**, by mail or email, no later than 11:59 p.m. on Wednesday, February 9, 2022. Completed petitions should be sent to the Executive Director of the West Virginia State Bar, 2000 Deitrick Boulevard, Charleston, WV 25311-1231 or [caseya@wvbar.org](mailto:caseya@wvbar.org). If multiple copies of the petition are used, they must be sent together.

Any nominee elected to the Board of Governors will be required to attend training on April 1, 2022 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. in room 161 (Bowers Room) at the WVU College of Law in Morgantown. Attendance at the Annual Meeting on April 10 and 11 in Charleston is required.
