

Edythe Nash Gaiser “Eydie” is the Clerk of Court for the Supreme Court of Appeals of West Virginia. Eydie was appointed Clerk of Court on November 1, 2017. She served as Deputy Clerk of Court from August 2003 until she was appointed Clerk of Court.

She is an active member of the National Conference of Appellate Court Clerks, and is currently the president. She served on the executive committee from 2013 through 2015, vendor chair 2013-2014, and program chair 2014-2015.
