RE: Election of Governors to the Board of Governors

The By-Laws of the West Virginia State Bar provide for the election of a member to the Board of Governors for a four-year term beginning March 26, 2023, from State Bar Districts 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5.

Nominations for the Board must be by written petition signed by not less than the number of members identified below who have their principal place of business in the same District as the nominee. No member shall sign more than one nominating petition in any year. The nominee must sign at least one of the petitions.

The counties comprising the electing districts and the number of required signatures are:

- 1 — Brooke, Hancock, and Ohio (10 required to nominate)
- 2 — Marshall, Pleasants, Tyler, and Wetzel (5 required to nominate)
- 3 — Calhoun, Gilmer, Ritchie, Wirt, and Wood (10 required to nominate)
- 4 — Clay, Jackson, Mason, Putnam, and Roane (10 required to nominate)
- 5 --- Cabell and Wayne (10 to nominate)

Once signed by the requisite number of members, the petition must be **RECEIVED**, by mail or email, no later than 11:59 p.m. on Wednesday, February 9, 2023. If multiple copies of the petition are used, they must be sent together.
